Homes, schools, shopping centres and rental properties all have two things in common, extremely high wastewater peak flow rates, and no way to predict what the users of the septic system are likely to put down the drains. This results in unfiltered solids leaving the septic tanks and a large number of absorption trenches failing. The Halgan™ septic tank with BioFilter performs two unique functions to overcome this.

Firstly, the BioFilter captures up to 90% of all solids larger than 3 mm, which is important as solids clog the soil surface, and prevent proper water absorption. The BioFilter also reduces 45% of BODS and 95% of oil and grease from the waste stream. The BioFilter is virtually self-cleaning as anaerobic organisms on the filter disc partially digest lodged particles causing the particles to lose buoyancy and fall to the bottom of the tank. Secondly, on servicing, only a quarter of the tank needs to be pumped out to remove the solids due to the combined servicing channel, and the BioFilters more efficient cleaning process. This also cuts down on pump out time and reduces frequency of pump outs.

Halgan's range of septic tanks with BioFilter are used in residential, commercial and industrial applications, holds AS1546.1 certification, complies with Septic Standard AS/NZS1546 and is approved for use nationally.

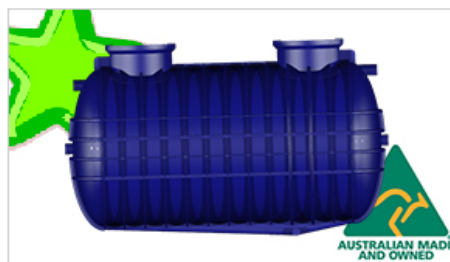


CUSTOM MADE FOR COFFS

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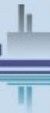
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
